**Written Examination - Pattern**

- Single paper objective type question
- OMR Answer coding sheet
- Four answer options (a, b, c, d)
- No negative marks
- Question booklet contains General Studies with General English and General Tamil. The candidate has to choose either 'General English' (or) 'General Tamil' and mark accordingly in the OMR sheet and answer the respective questions according to their choice.
- The questions for General Studies will be bilingual (English and Tamil)
- Single common examination for the post of Junior Assistant and Typist will be conducted, since the syllabus is common for both the posts.
- The preference for the choice of the post will be obtained at the time of counseling (for certificate verification) from the short listed candidates who have applied for both the posts i.e. Junior Assistant and Typist.

**(I) Question paper pattern / marks**

a) General Studies (SSLC Standard)	-	100 questions (150 marks)
b) General English (or) General Tamil (SSLC Standard)	-	100 questions (150 marks)
c) Total number of questions	-	200
d) Total marks	-	300 marks
e) Time duration	-	3 hours
f) Qualifying marks	-	35% (i.e. 105 out of 300 marks)

**(II) Tie-breaking norms**

- If two or more candidates secured equal marks in the written examination for a post, the candidate who is senior in age will be placed above in the merit / rank list.
- If date of birth is also the same, the average percentage of marks secured in the qualification prescribed for the post(Higher Secondary course for Junior Assistant post / SSLC for Typist post) will be considered.
- If marks in the written examination, age and average percentage of marks in the qualification prescribed for the post are equal, the candidates with the highest random number will be placed above in the merit / rank list.

**(III) Examination Centre**

The written examination will be conducted in selected major cities / towns in Tamil Nadu based on the number of the candidates in that district and in the few neighboring districts (as in communication address).

The examination centre for candidates from other states will be allotted at Chennai.
